
#### Hospital Cost Drivers

 Prices directly related to the costs of providing services to patients and communities

- Prices reflect:
  - Wages
  - Capital Investment
  - Level and specialization of care
  - Increasing uncompensated care




# Hospital costs have accounted for a steady proportion of national/state healthcare expenditures






Hospital costs are directly related to the cost of providing health care to patients






Medicare and Medi-Cal account for over \$8 billion of the \$12.2 billion in uncompensated care costs for hospitals





#### Impact of Medicare and Medicaid Shortfalls on Hospitals, 2009-2019





- California has led the nation in costeffectiveness
- History of payment and care delivery innovation
- Lower per capital health care costs
- Health care reform will move more patients to Medicare and Medi-Cal
- Costs are driven by cost inputs
