CDI Introduction



Owned by nearly 300 California dairy families.

From San Diego County in the south to Sacramento County in the north, our independent, family-owned member dairies dot California's rural landscape. All of the milk used to produce our high quality, safe and nutritious dairy products originates at one of our member-owners' dairy farms. CDI is the second largest milk marketing cooperative in the United States with 6 processing facilities throughout CA.

- BILLION POUNDS of average annual member milk production (60.5 billion liters)
- PERCENT of our member-owner farms are located within 100 miles of a CDI facility
 - **PERCENT** of total US Production
- 1,800 AVERAGE HERD SIZE at our member-owner farms
 - PERCENT of California's total milk production is from CDI member-owners

H5N1 Impact on Dairy Cattle



- Flu like symptoms
- Reduction in milk production
 - Varies from cow to cow
- Impacts to dairies include:
 - Milk Losses
 - Treatment Costs
 - Mortalities
 - Abortions
 - Breeding interruptions
 - Long term effects unknown!

Agency Coordination - Concerns



Local/County

- New virus
 - Lack of information regarding virus transmission, vulnerable groups, etc.
 - Communicated extensively with employees around safety protocols
 - PPE Provided
- No ability to locally test Davis, CA and confirmed back east

State

 Concerned about the border stations' ability to monitor and perform their duties and meet expectations

Federal

Lack of coordination between USDA and CDFA on-farm personnel

 FREE PPE distribution/delivery coordinated with local health departments and MHOAC

- State Vet Jones Amazing advocate and leader for CA Livestock
- CDFA's communication with industry
- Coordination between milk handlers and lab helped streamline testing early in outbreak
